Know all by these presents, that the undersigned hereby constitutes and appoints each of Margaret Austin Wright and Elizabeth Hensen and any duly appointed Corporate Secretary of CME Group, Inc. (the "Company"), with full power of substitution and re-substitution, acting individually, as the undersigned's true and lawful attorney-in-fact, with full power and authority as hereinafter described on behalf of and in the name, place and stead of the undersigned to:
